



Mausoleum

The community mausoleum provides a clean and dry environment for the entombment of loved ones and also cremated remains. Those who select crypts in the mausoleum may use the chapel in that building for their committal services. Floral Haven also offers the option of designing private family mausoleums along the Lakes of Reflection.



Crematory

Floral Haven is one of the few funeral homes in the state to own and operate its own private crematory. This complete facility offers families the option of being present

during the cremation process and provides the added assurance that your loved one is never out of our care or trusted to an outside cremation service provider. We also offer special gardens in the cemetery specifically designed for those families who select cremation. The Whispering Waters Cremation Garden includes niches, natural stone memorials and a scattering ossuary.



Family Center

In 1995 Floral Haven opened the Family Center. This was the first reception center of its kind in Green Country. Located just north of Floral Haven Funeral Home, the Family Center features two large reception rooms with kitchens for after service gatherings, each equipped with large plasma screens for viewing family movies or tributes.

These facilities are available free of charge to any family that plans their funeral services through Floral Haven Funeral Home. We provide flatware, plates, coffee, tea and setup staff as a part of the service. Food may be provided by your church group, family and friends or through a catering service.

Floral Reminder

To continue our efforts to keep Floral Haven the most beautiful cemetery in Oklahoma...

December 1st to February 28th

Any appropriate winter decorations may be placed in the vase or on the ground over the grave. Fresh grave blankets will be removed on February 1st.

March 1st to March 31st

To prepare for spring, the grounds crew will be spraying and fertilizing during the month of March. This requires that all of the vases be turned down. Anyone wishing to save their winter grave decorations must remove them prior to March 1st.

April 1 to December 1

Fresh and artificial flowers are permitted at ALL TIMES in regulation floral vases.

Memorial Day

All floral decorations are permitted in both the vase and on the grave. Everything except arrangements in the vases must be removed after one week.
