



# Floral Haven Property Map

## Floral Reminder

Fresh and artificial flowers are permitted at ALL TIMES in regulation vases with the exception of March. Please see below.

### December 1st to February 28th

Any appropriate winter decorations may be placed in the vase or on the ground over the grave. Fresh grave blankets will be removed on February 1st.

### March 1st to March 31st

To prepare for Spring, the grounds crew will be spraying and fertilizing during the month of March. This requires that all of the vases be turned down. Anyone wishing to save their winter grave decorations must remove them prior to March 1st.

### Memorial Day


All floral decorations are permitted in both the vase and on the grave. Everything except arrangements in the vases must be removed after one week.

### Above Ground Entombment– Mausoleums

Above ground entombment has been the preferred form of honoring the deceased for centuries. Consider the Taj Majal, the Westminster Abbey, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and Joseph of Arimathea who donated his tomb to Jesus of Nazareth. We offer private custom mausoleum estates, 2 indoor community mausoleums with chapels, and an outdoor mausoleum with plans to add more in the future as space is needed.

### Traditional Ground Burial– Burial Gardens



Floral Haven currently has 29 gardens that are dedicated to ground burial. A favorite option is the family estate which can accommodate

up to 24 burial rites along with many customizations that can be determined with your pre-arrangement specialist.

*Memorialization is important to future generations so they may understand those who walked before them.*

### Cremation Options

Floral Haven is in the unique position to have our own crematory where a family can be involved as much or as little as they deem appropriate. When selecting cremation, it is important to remember that memorialization can be customized just as you would with ground burial. An urn can be placed in a cremation garden or with a loved one who has selected traditional burial or a mausoleum. Some of the more personalized options include boulders and benches that add to the aesthetics of the gardens, pedestals which can be designed to reflect tastes, hobbies or interests. We also offer glass front niches where mementos of a life well lived can be put on display with the urn.

Our *Grief Recovery Program* has helped countless individuals with healing after a loss.

Did you know that Floral Haven will provide the burial of any child under the age of 13, free of charge?

We are also deeply involved in our community as well as offering support to several Veterans programs.
