Gary Arland McBryde, MD, 72, resident of Tulsa, Oklahoma, passed away August 23, 2019. Gary was born March 25, 1947, in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, to Luther and Fredine McBryde. Gary attended the University of Arkansas School of Medicine, and obtained his Medical Degree in 1976. He completed his residency in Internal Medicine in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and started his solo practice in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, in 1980. He later joined Warren Clinic, and retired after 36 years of practice in 2016. His nurses and office staff over the years were like family to him. He truly cared about the welfare of his patients, and stayed in touch with many of them up to the end. Gary enjoyed his career with Saint Francis Health Systems, and often said he bled “Pink”. He had such a great respect for his colleagues, and enjoyed the lasting friendships he made during his career. Close friends, that were beyond special to him, are Dr. Bill and Barbara McEntee, Dr. Steve and Teresa Parker, and the late Mrs. Pat Parker. Bill and Steve were his “brothers” and their love has been unconditional over the years.
