LeRoy Pennyman, 60 of Tulsa, Oklahoma passed from this life on Friday, December 28, 2018 at his home in Tulsa with his family by his side. He was born February 4, 1958 in Barnesville, Georgia to his parents, Thomas Walker and Blanche Pennyman. LeRoy moved to Tulsa from Thomaston, Georgia in 1989 to attend Rhema Bible College where he completed his Pastoral Studies in 1991. After completing his studies at Rhema Bible College he went to work for Price Mart where he worked as a Produce Manager and then later when the company was acquired by Reasor's he was promoted to Store Director. LeRoy loved and was a loyal fan of the Atlanta Braves, Atlanta Falcons, and the Georgia Bulldogs even after moving to Oklahoma. He loved to study and live God's word and was even a youth leader at Pine Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Yatesville, Georgia and was a youth minister volunteer at New Life Church in Thomaston, Georgia. LeRoy loved to teach and mentor youth by being a former Scout Master for Troop 133 in Georgia. Also, during his leadership, he mentored the first African American Eagle Scout Troop in the Flint River District in Georgia.
