Annabelle was born on December 4th, 1935, in the small town of Rose Valley, Saskatchewan, Canada. She passed away in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on December 10, 2018. She is survived by her husband of 62 years, James Sullins, her children, Tracy and Leslie, her grandson, Thor, her sister, Olive Eckstein, and many loving nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, Henry and Augusta Thorson; one brother, Miles Thorson; and one sister, Carole Grovum.
