Patrick Hunton, 65 of Claremore, Oklahoma passed from this life on Saturday, August 11, 2018 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was born November 12, 1952 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, a son of Herchell Dean Hunton and Rose Darlene Perkins Moody. Patrick married the love of his life, Tracey Ellen Bond Hunton on May 17th, 1985 in Miami, Oklahoma. Pat had a passion for music, sports and family. Whether it was his daughters, grandsons, nieces or nephews, there wasn't a performance or game that was missed if he could help it. Pat spent his high school years playing lead guitar and singing in the band The Blu Mods, putting on dances at the Rolling Hills Fire Department and surrounding areas. Winning the battle of the Kings in 1968 was a highlight of that time in his life. Pat loved OU Football, the Dallas Cowboys and OKC Thunder and enjoyed watching them play.
