He went to be with the Lord on August 8, 2018 at the age of 75 in Tulsa, OK. Jack attended public school in Tulsa and graduated from Central High School. As he stood by a cute girl with curls named Pat in his third-grade class picture, he was unaware that this girl would end up being his high school sweetheart and future wife. They married August 10, 1963, had a wonderful life together and loved each other deeply. After two years of college at the University of Tulsa, Jack enlisted in the Air Force where he spent time in Bermuda and at Edwards Air Force Base in California.
