He graduated from Northwest Classen HS in 1970 and then attended the University of Oklahoma where he was a member of the Sigma Nu Fraternity. He graduated from OU in 1975 with his bachelor's in Political Science. He then on to pursue his Master's in Environmental Science at the University of Texas at Dallas and his MBA from the University of Dallas. It was during his undergrad time in Norman that he met his wife Mary McClymonds Thompson and they were married on January 8, 1977. They had three children, Libby, Ben, and Sam.
