Norma Dell Bowling, wife, mother, sister, grandmother, great-grandmother and friend to many, passed from this life on Sunday, September 3, 2017. Norma celebrated her 87th birthday on August 27th. Norma was born at home, in Tulsa, OK on Wednesday, August, 27, 1930 to parents Ruth Irene and William Clayton Rudd. She attended Alice Roberson Elementary School, Clinton Junior High School and Daniel Webster High School where she graduated in 1948. Siblings include sisters Billie Irene Rudd Hopkins and Beverly Dean Rudd Barber and brother Buck Alan Rudd. After graduation, Norma and life-long friend Wanda Fields traveled to Washington DC where they went to work for the Civil Service in the Navy Department and met their future husbands. Norma and E. C.
