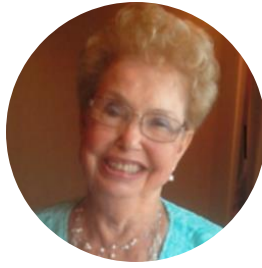

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 PM, Friday, October 28, 2016 at Yale Avenue Christian Church, with burial to follow at Floral Haven Memorial Gardens.
