Mary Beth Robinson, beloved wife, mother, grandmother and sister passed away peacefully in her sleep May 31, 2016. She was a beloved kindergarten and grade school teacher in the Broken Arrow Public School system for over 30 years, mostly at Oak Crest Elementary School. She was a longtime member of the First Presbyterian Church of Broken Arrow and lived her faith every day. She was born in Spiro, Oklahoma to Ruth and Walter Rhodes. She acquired a “Teacher’s Certificate” during WWII. While getting her certificate, met the love of her life, Edward Frank Robinson at what was then known as Tahlequah Teacher’s College. They married and enjoyed a long loving 64 years together until Ed was called to heaven in 2013. She was proud mother of two children, Stephen Edward Robinson of Broken Arrow and Sue Jane Volarich of Springfield, Illinois.
