Daniel R. Lopez, 89, passed away at home April 1, 2016, in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Danny was born April 7, 1926 in Paint Rock, Texas to Vicente and Estella Lopez. Danny was raised in Fredericksburg, Texas, and lived in San Antonio, Texas before moving to Tulsa, Oklahoma. He served honorably in the U.S. Army during World War II. He started his lifelong career in the linen business in San Antonio, Texas, and then Springdale, Arkansas, where he met the love of his life. He spent 35 years at Superior Linen based in Tulsa. He retired in 2004, devoting his time to growing fabulous tomatoes and helping at the family farm in Arkansas.
