Donald William Landburg died at his home on Sunday, February 8, 2015 at the age of 83. Donald was born June 15, 1931 to William Reuben and Elsie Selck Landburg at McLean Nebraska. He was raised on a farm in Nebraska and Fergus Falls Minnesota. He graduated from Underwood High School in Underwood Minnesota in 1950. After graduation, he joined the United States Air Force and served in the military from 1950 to 1960. He advanced to Tech Sergeant serving at Barksdale AFB in San Juan Puerto Rico, Ft. Bragg in El Paso Texas, and Eglin AFB in Florida. Donald served in the US Army Reserves for 2 years after retirement from the Air Force.
