Corene E. Adams Corene Elinor (Finley) Adams passed away peacefully in Tulsa on Thursday, April 18, 2013, at the age of 79. Corene was born in Iola, Kansas, on March 14, 1934. She graduated from Central High School with the class of 1952 and was a lifelong Tulsa resident. Among other roles, she worked as the switchboard operator and registrar at Edison High School, eventually retiring from Tulsa Public Schools after more than 40 years of service. She enjoyed playing dominoes and games, cheering her favorite sports teams, following the weather, and spending time with her many friends and family. Ms. Adams was involved with American Legion Post 308 and a faithful member of Eastwood Baptist Church.
