Randall was a member of Community Christian Church, DOC, and was baptized when he was 10 years old. At age 14, he was diagnosed with cancer and fought a lengthy battle culminating with a successful bone marrow transplant in October of 1996. He was an avid gaming fan, and was often among the first to purchase new releases of such games as Oblivion, Assassin's Creed, Call of Duty, and many more. He bought many lottery tickets over the years, always promising to provide first for his brothers and sisters by getting each of them homes, cars, an education so that they could start life on a firm foundation. And he often hoped to one day own his own comic book shop. He was working on a science fiction novel at the time of his death.
