Joan worked in various Broken Arrow School cafeterias for several years. She and her husband, George Ernest Miller, were long time members of The First Baptist Church of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. They managed the Grand Motel in Grove, Oklahoma for fifteen years after leaving Broken Arrow. In later years, they moved from Grove to Princeton, Texas to a mobile home their son, Sam, provided for them. They helped look after his storage business and enjoyed their new home and community.
