Bob was born in Oklahoma City, OK on January 1, 1927, to Jeannie and Owen Bruton. He was the first New Year's baby born in Oklahoma City that year. The family later moved to Norman, OK where Bob graduated from Norman High School. After high school he entered the United States Army and served in the Philippines. When Bob left the Army, he enrolled at Oklahoma University and earned his Civil Engineer Degree. The family moved to Tulsa in 1959 where Bob started a very exciting and rewarding career. Bob's company, BKL Engineering, was involved in the Riverside Drive Extension, Turnpikes, the County Jail, the IDL Loop, the Broken Arrow Expressway, the Port of Catoosa, and numerous other projects.
