Loyce Lucille Knight, 93 of Tulsa, passed from this life on April 3, 2011. She was born on March 12, 1918 in Gans, Oklahoma to Orie Lee and Eunice Earl (Carter) Powell. She spent all of her childhood in Panama, Oklahoma. Loyce married Russell N. Knight of Van Buren, Arkansas at the age of 23 on April 9, 1941 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. In 1946 when Russell returned from WWII, Loyce, Russell and their first son Tim moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma. Russell was a bus driver for Greyhound Lines and Loyce was a stay at home mom.
