Janet Joan Martin died Friday , February 4, 2011, at home with family, after a five year battle with cancer. She was born October 1, 1930, in Terre Haute, Indiana to Wiley and Esther Greenleaf. She graduated from Garfield High School and attended Indiana State University for two years before being employed by General Motors Acceptance Corp. She married George D. Martin on December 8, 1950. (The couple had just celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.) Janet continued her employment with GMAC after the couple moved to Tulsa, as George was hired by KVOO news. She retired as accounting manager after 44 years. Janet loved to be active. She never missed an opportunity to swim, and played golf regularly.
