**B**ob Hines, age 66 years and 6 months, of Tulsa passed from this life on Friday, January 28, 2010. He was born on July 14, 1944 in Poteau, Oklahoma to Bob and Willajo Hines. Bob graduated from Central High School and the Oklahoma School of Accounting and served his country with the U.S. Navy. Bob married Nancy (Taylor) Hines on March 20, 1982 in Tulsa. He was a Supervisory Auditor with the U.S. Dept. of Interior. He was the past President of the Heartland Council of the Institute of Management Accounting and a member of New Beginnings Church. He was also the past President of the Communications Federal Credit Union, and was an Assistant Manager of Tulsa Federal Credit Union. Bob was a loving husband, father and family man.
