Donna Mae DeBusk passed away on September 6, 2020 following a brief intestinal illness. She was 75 years old.

Donna was born the tenth child to William Arthur and Mabel Ann Howell on June 28, 1945 in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. She was a spirited girl by her own account, and enjoyed playing with the McCoy's and going to matinees and church.
