## **Rilda Jean Frisby**

NOV 28, 1926 - NOV 9, 2020

**R**ilda Jean Frisby was born in Checotah Oklahoma, November 28, 1926 and passed away at the age of 93 on November 9th, 2020.

She was the fifth child of seven brothers and sisters and lived in Warner Oklahoma. After losing her mother at age 5, she along with her siblings were raised by her father, grandparents, aunts and uncles. Her father would pass away when she was 16 at which time she moved to Tulsa to live with her sister Merle under the watchful eye of their Aunt Mary. She completed her education at night school while working a full time job during the day. In Tulsa she met and married Lloyd Franks in 1946. They were married 31 years and raised two children, Frankie and Susan. She lost the love of her life in 1977 when Lloyd passed away unexpectedly. Rilda would find love and companionship again in 1987, marrying Glenn Frisby. They would remain together for 13 years until Glenn's passing in 2000. Rilda worked for 43 years in the insurance industry before retiring in 1986. She enjoyed travelling having spent a summer in Morocco with her sister and a summer in Florida with friends, and several trips to Europe with daughter Frankie and grandchildren Michaley and Wes. She was a lifelong avid reader and would rather spend time with a book than the television. Rilda was a long time member of Eastwood Baptist Church. She had an unwavering faith in God and knew that when she was to be called home it would be into the arms of her savior.
