Graveside services will be private at Floral Haven Memorial Gardens in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.



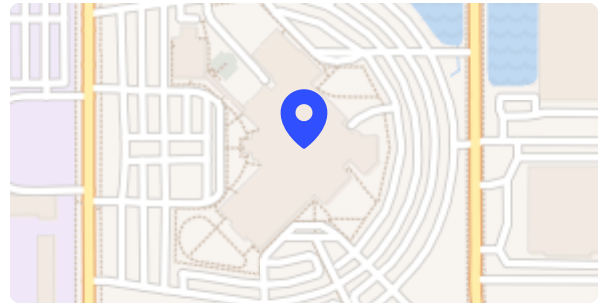
