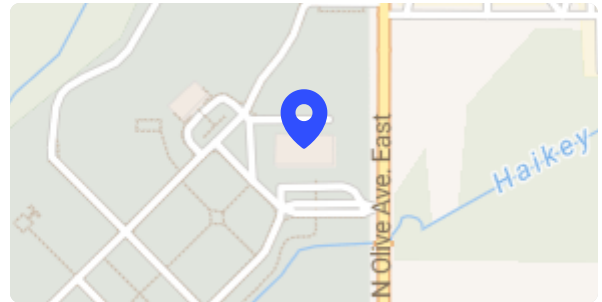
Graveside Service will be 1:00 PM, Tuesday, September 21, 2021 at Floral Haven Garden of Gethsemane.

Celebration of Life Service will follow the graveside at 2:00 PM, September 21, 2021 at Asbury United Methodist Church.



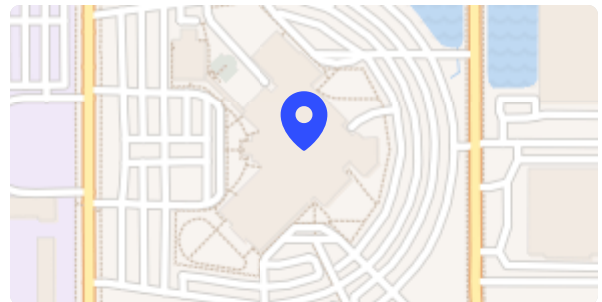

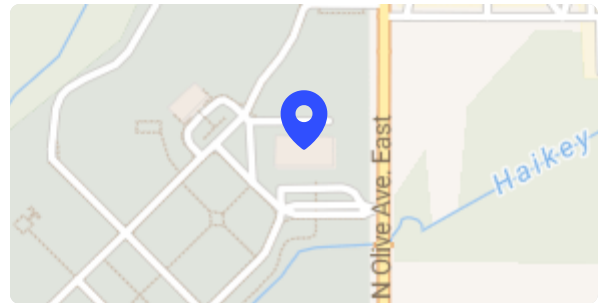
