# Kathleen Mangan Stouffer

**K**athleen Mangan Stouffer passed from this life on June 21, 2022, Kathleen was born in Tulsa on July 21, 1937 to Lawrence and Emma Mangan. She was preceded in death by her parents, a sister Carol and brother Thomas. Growing up, Kathleen lived in Tulsa, Oklahoma City, Krebs, Little Rock, Kansas City and in Houston, Texas from 1947 to 1956. In 1955 Kathleen graduated from Reagan High School, Houston where she played bugle in the marching band and was a Rainbow girl.

In 1956, Kathleen and the Mangan family moved to Salt Lake City, Utah where she worked for Blue Cross. In Salt Lake City, Kathleen met Steve Stouffer at her Methodist Church where they were married in 1960. Son Mark was born in 1961 in Salt Lake and daughter Sheryl was born in Casper, Wyoming 1964 where Steve worked for Amoco Corp. In 1965, the Stouffers were transferred to Denver, CO and 6 months later to Calgary, Alberta, Canada where they lived for 8 years, enjoying ice skating, hockey, Canadian football, fishing, hiking and camping.
