The intimate graveside service for close family and friends, will be on October 21, 10:00 am, at Memorial Park Cemetery. Please notify family for further directions.

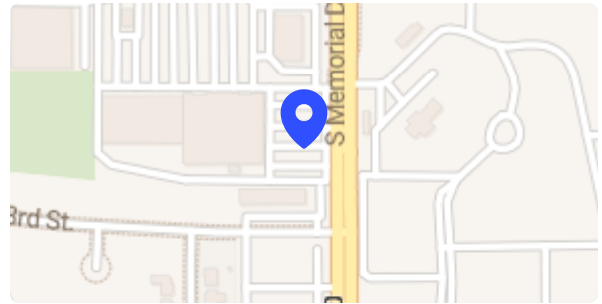

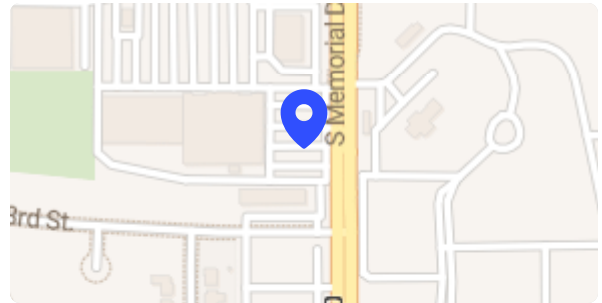

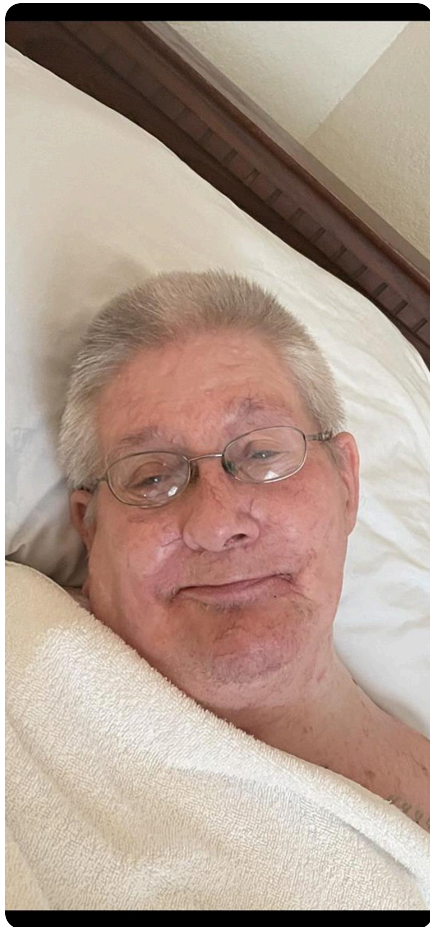
