**R**obert George Roe, Jr, 77 years old of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, died on Saturday, December 24th, 2022 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Born on April 27th, 1945 in Superior, Wisconsin to Robert and Edith Roe.

Robert graduated from Pewaukee High School in Pewaukee, Wisconsin and Grace Fellowship's School of the Local Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He attended and volunteered at Immanuel Lutheran Church (Broken Arrow), Grace Fellowship (Tulsa), and The Bridge (Bixby). Robert volunteered at Mend Crisis Pregnancy Center, Loaves and Fishes, and as chaplain at the Ford Glass Plant (Tulsa) and at the Trucker's Chapel (Catoosa). 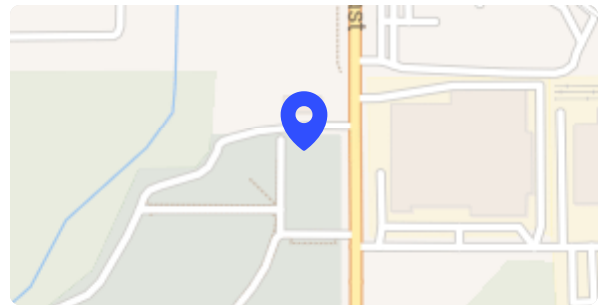
