## **Clyde Julian Case**

JUL 4, 1922 - DEC 21, 2022

**C**lyde Case, age 100, passed from this life Wednesday, December 21, 2022, in Tulsa, Oklahoma after a long journey with dementia. Clyde Julian Case was born July 04, 1922, to Clyde Harold and Juliette Julian Case in Coffeyville, Kansas. Clyde was very proud to be a Veteran of World War II. His service began with training in England and ended as a top-turret gunner on a B-24 in the Panama Canal Zone. After the war he returned to Tulsa where his sister introduced him to the love of his life, Colleen Pritchard. They had two children while he had a long career in drafting and engineering that took him to job sites in Denver, Los Angeles and Tulsa. He retired in Tulsa. He and Colleen were long-time members at Eastland Baptist Church and the Heritage Sunday School Class where they loved the preaching, teaching and community they found there. He was predeceased by Colleen, his son, Clyde Jr, his parents and sister, Lillian Cogswell and brother-in-law Robert. 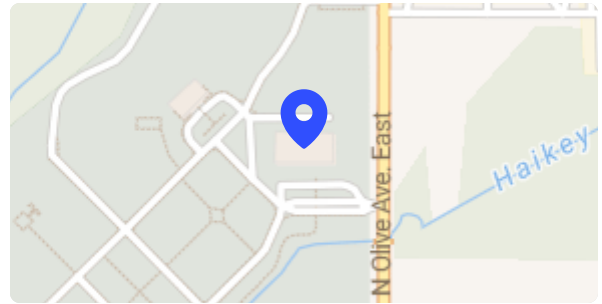
