Victor, Allen Whiteside, 91, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, passed away March 2, 2023. Vic was born on September 19, 1931, in Manhattan, Kansas, to Fay Allen Whiteside and Doii Eckart.

Victor attended Oklahoma State University until the Army called him to serve in Germany during the Korean War. He then worked in the oil industry, staying with the same company 35 years until he retired. He loved cars and made 100's of exquisite miniature model cars. Victor also loved to travel and try new things: white water rafting in his 50's and jungle zip lining in his 80's. He was a scholar and a gentleman and will be missed.
