Charities she supported were Children’s Medical Center, Tunnels to Towers, and South Tulsa Baptist Church.






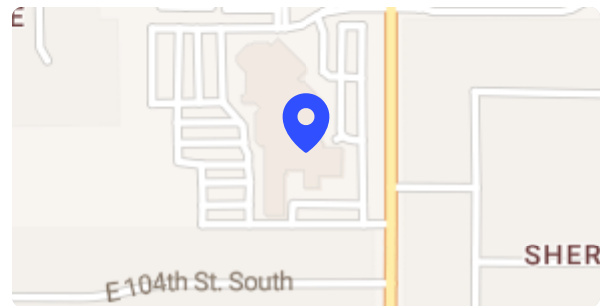

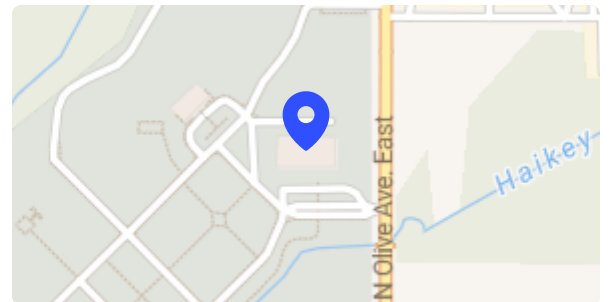
