Don spent many years working for General Dynamics in NJ before moving to Bixby, OK in 1977. They relocated to Jenks in 2000 and he retired from Polyvision Corp. in 2009. 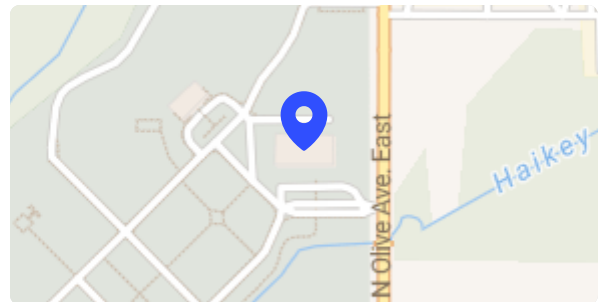

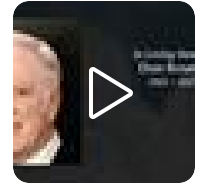
