Celebration of Life service will be 2 pm on Thursday, May 18, 2023, at Heritage Church Broken Arrow 5300 E Kenosha St (71st).

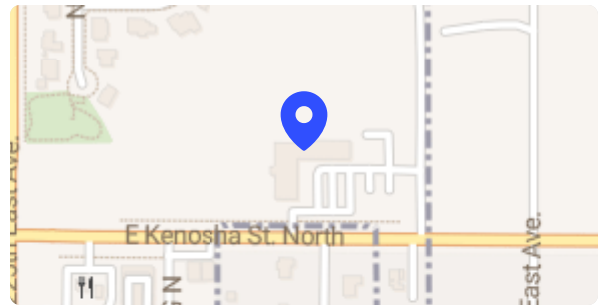
