Charles William McEntee, a compassionate and dedicated cardiologist, passed away on July 4, 2023, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Born on June 4, 1949, in Muskogee, Oklahoma, Charles was the beloved son of Jess and Helen McEntee (Bender).

From a young age, Charles exhibited a remarkable work ethic, beginning his career at the Muskogee Hospital at the age of 16. His passion for medicine led him to attend the OU Medical School, and later the Baylor College of Medicine for his Cardiology fellowship.

After a fulfilling career as a cardiologist, Charles retired from his practice but continued to serve his community as a dedicated board member for Saint Francis Hospital. Known for his selflessness and commitment to others, Charles actively sought ways to give back and make a difference in the lives of those around him.

Outside of his profession, Charles found joy in photography and traveling. Capturing life's fleeting moments through his lens brought him great happiness. Additionally, he was an active member of the Founder's Society for the Tulsa Ballet, showcasing his support for the arts.

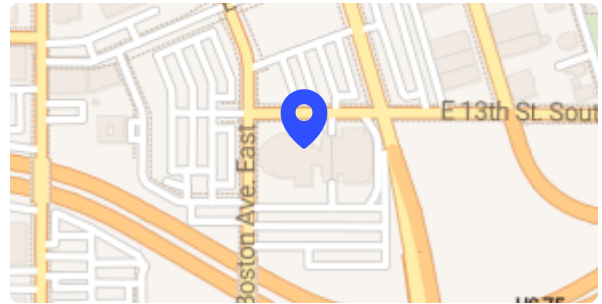
