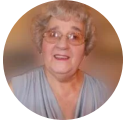

Visitation will be 3-7 pm, Wednesday, July 12, 2023, at Floral Haven Funeral Home.

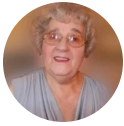

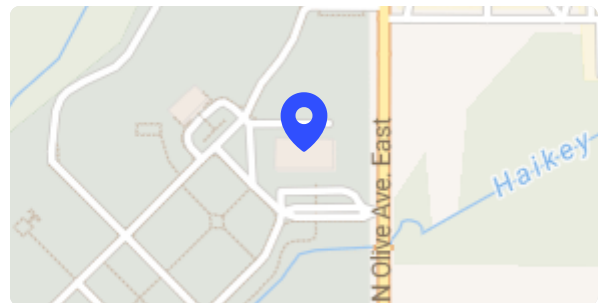

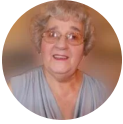
