A Pillar of Strength and a Legacy of Love

Carol Ann (Johnson) Siling, 74, of Tulsa, OK, beloved daughter, sister, mother, aunt, and grandmother, peacefully went home to rest in the arms of Jesus on April 23, 2024, finally relieved from a tenacious 14-month battle with Stage IV liver cancer.

Carol was born on March 14, 1950 to William and Roberta (Reniker) Johnson in Joplin, Missouri and raised in Independence, Kansas until age 13 when the family moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma, where she graduated from Nathan Hale High School. Carol began a steadfast career in the telecommunications industry, serving in management capacities for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company/AT&T from 1977 to 2003, which ultimately took her to Oklahoma City, where she raised her daughter.

Her journey was marked by significant achievements, including obtaining a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Oklahoma City University, then a Master of Science degree from OSU-Tulsa in Teaching, Learning, and Leadership in 2006 to pursue her life-long dream of teaching higher education adult education courses at various educational institutions.

Carol and her parents survived the traumatic Joplin, MO F-5 tornado on May 22, 2011, inside the hospital that had a direct hit and credited the Lord for protecting them.

She loved her family tremendously. The family farm in Joplin, MO held a special place in her heart, spanning cherished memories from her early childhood to her later years. It was a haven of warmth, laughter, and connection, where family bonds were nurtured, creating treasured reminders of love, joy, and the timeless embrace of family. In anticipation of becoming a grandma, she moved back to Tulsa, OK. Carol embraced her role as a grandmother with boundless love and enthusiasm, always savoring growth and milestones, while being tremendously proud of her grandchildren. She was a devoted daughter and moved her parents in

Being a part of The Park Prison and Jail Ministry was one of her biggest blessings in life where she looked forward to weekly Bible studies with incarcerated women, expressing her immense gratitude for the opportunity to see God work in the hearts of the women she encountered.

Carol remained a pillar of strength, encouragement and love in her actions, words, and thoughtful notes. Through her selflessness and dedication, she imparted invaluable lessons of resilience, kindness, and perseverance to her family and friends, leaving an indelible mark on the lives of those she touched. Her boundless compassion, coupled with her steadfast faith, served as a beacon of light, inspiring others. Carol's legacy of love and Christian faithfulness will continue to resonate in the hearts of those she touched, forever reminding us of the power of kindness and unwavering faith in God.

Carol was preceded in death by her father, William Layton Johnson. She is survived by her mother, Roberta A.
