Cora Lee Egwuonwu, 73, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully at her home on August 10, 2024. Born on June 30, 1951, in Elko, Nevada, she was the beloved daughter of Clarence Mosley and Katherine Bell.

Cora was a woman of many passions and talents. She loved to spend her Sundays at IHOP, enjoying the company of friends and family. 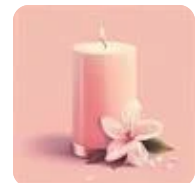

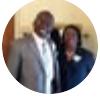
