It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Edwin Eugene Luce, 81, of Broken Arrow, OK on November 12, 2024.

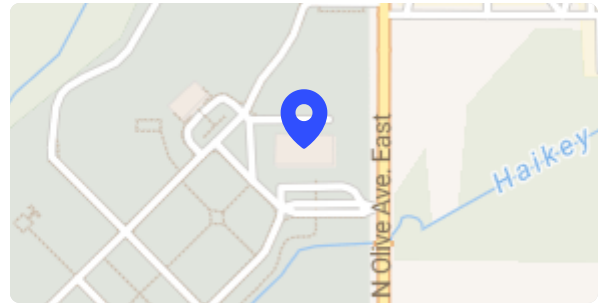
