Linda Lee Aycock passed from this life on Saturday, November 23, 2024, in a Tulsa hospital with family by her side. She was born October 10, 1960, in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Marvin Lee and Marjorie Laverne (Turner) Trammell.

Linda loved her family and enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren, whether at sporting events or simply playing outdoors. She loved her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and was a longtime member of Bethany Church. She spent many years co-teaching the two- and three-year-old's Sunday School class; instilling in those young minds that Jesus loved them and wanted to be their very best friend. 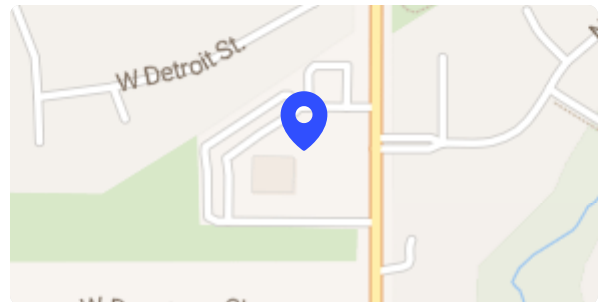
