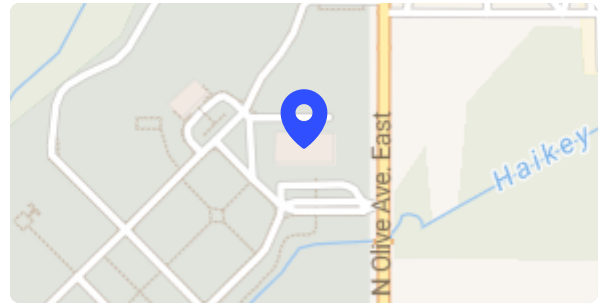

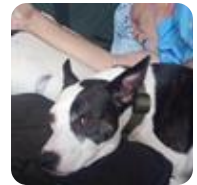
Johnny saved my life one time. I was on crutches and started to fall off my back porch and Johnny caught me!!!!
