Betty Lou Turner's legacy will live on through her art and the memories shared by all who knew her. Rest in peace, Betty.

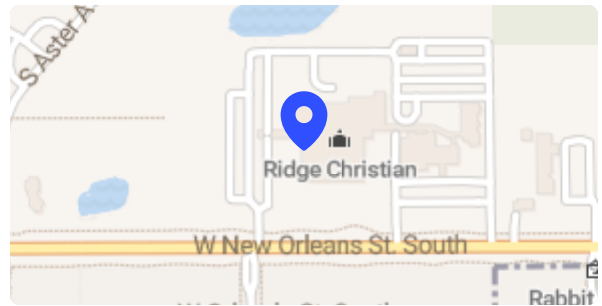
