Ronald Leon Mask, 78, of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully at home on Tuesday, February 11, 2025.

Ron was born on April 21, 1946, at St. Joseph Hospital in Fort Worth, Texas, to Guy Leon Mask and Molly Francis (Henry) Mask. He grew up in Fort Worth and attended North Side High School before proudly serving his country in the U.S. Army as a sergeant in the 7th Corps 34th Signal Battalion from 1964 to 1967. He continued his service in the U.S. Army Reserves until 1970.

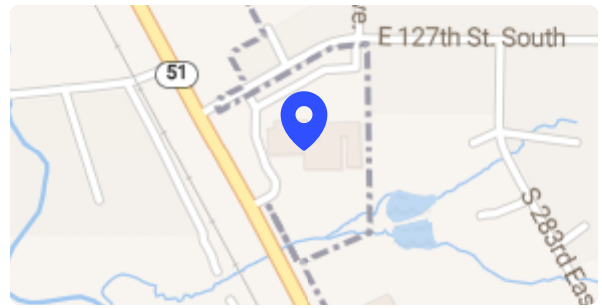
