Such precious and fun memories. Yes, dad had a special way of teaching us life long lessons. We are truly blessed. We are so proud of each of you and love you dearly!!!



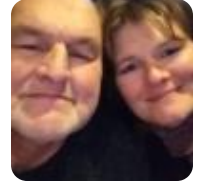
