Edward Albert Cook (Butch) age 82, resided in Broken Arrow, OK, passed away Monday October 27th 2025, at Saint Francis Hospital.

Ed was born on December 10th 1942, in Flint Michigan to Ed and Edna (Meredith) Cook. He married Annetta Blazier October 10th 1963, and divorced in 1999. Ed married Virginia (Ginny) Copeland on April 26th, 2003. He graduated from Mott Community College in Flint Michigan with an associate degree. Additionally, he graduated from Rhema Bible Training Center in 2002 with a Pastor's Degree and he was an ordained minister with World Outreach Church of Tulsa.

Earlier in life, he was a business entrepreneur owning several IHOPs and Precision Tunes. For 12 years, Ed and Ginny completed multiple mission trips in over 20 countries, then for the past 10 years they lived, pastored and oversaw 5 churches in Nicaragua.

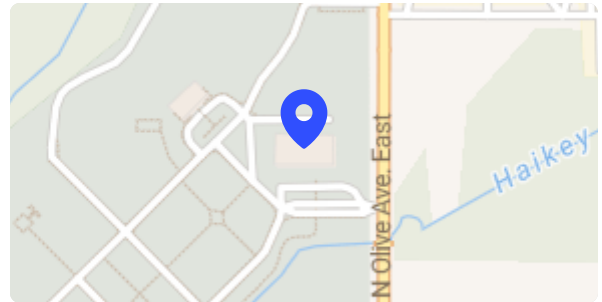

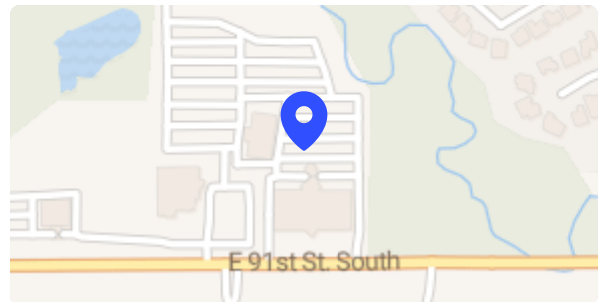

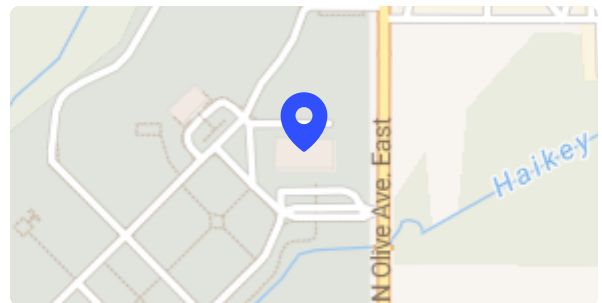
