Cynthia Ann “Cindy” Williams went home to be with the Lord on November 13, 2025, in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. She was born on August 5, 1948, in Temple, Texas, to Adolph and Clara Junek.

Cindy was raised in a loving, faith-filled home with her brother, Adolph Jr. After graduating from Temple High School, she proudly earned her degree from Baylor University. She became an elementary school teacher in Waxahachie, Texas—where she met the love of her life, Bob (“Pug”) Williams, who was then serving as the YMCA director. Their connection was instant and enduring. They married on July 29, 1972, beginning a partnership defined by deep love, mutual respect, and unwavering devotion.

When Cindy married Bob, she gained an instant family with his children, Stacy and Scott. Together, Cindy and Bob welcomed two daughters—Jennifer in 1974 and Carey in 1976. She devoted herself wholeheartedly to motherhood. Whether she was baking after-school cookies, cheering her children on in their activities, or modeling steadiness and grace, she was present for every moment. 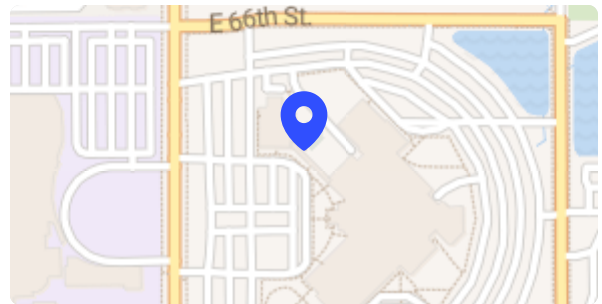
