# Maxwell Willard Longacre Jr.

**M**axwell Willard Longacre Jr., affectionately known to many as Buster, Buzz, or Buddy, passed away at the age of 80 on Friday, January 9, 2026 at Norman Regional Hospital. Though he passed in Norman, Oklahoma, Maxwell had most recently made his home in Choctaw, Oklahoma.

Maxwell was born on November 6, 1945, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Maxwell Willard Longacre Sr. and Marguerite Doran Culwell. From an early age, he was known for his friendly nature and the nicknames that followed him throughout his life - "Buster" during childhood, "Buzz," and most fondly, "Buddy," a name many continued to call him well into adulthood.

He was a proud graduate of the University of Oklahoma, where he earned a double major in Business Management and Management Information Systems, graduating in 1985. 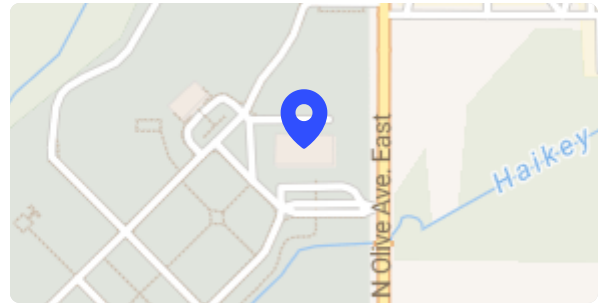
