Elvis "Berneil" Roger's son of Charlie Bell Rogers and Ruby Lee Cunningham Rogers was born August 21, 1931 and left this life for a better place February 8, 2026 at the age of 94.

Berneil, as he was known to most people, attended school in Leachville, Arkansas and Berryhill High School. He graduated from Northeastern State University with a master's degree in education, He was a principal/teacher for 24 years in Cherokee, Muskogee and Tulsa Counties. He pastored churches for 54 years.

Berneil married his High School sweetheart Mae Mefford on October 5, 1951 and together they raised two children Berneil Wayne Rogers of Nevada, Missouri and Marsha Lynn Harper of Jenks, Oklahoma. Berneil was blessed with 10 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.

Berneil was preceded in death by his parents; wife Delphia "Mae" Rogers; brothers Charles Donald, Billy Wayne, and Jimmy Doyle; two sisters Marcelleta Kelly and Geraldine Click; two nephews Billy Don Lewallen and Michael Dean Rogers. 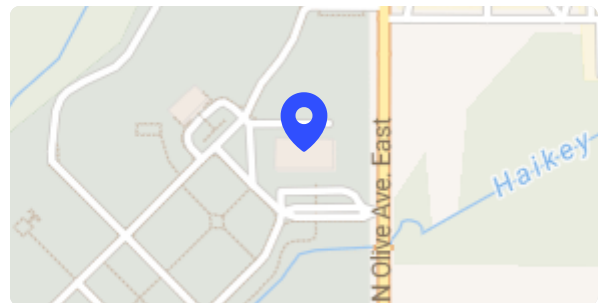
