She was born on February 18, 1935, in Stigler, Oklahoma, to Leamon and Irene (Harrell) Lewis, and her life was marked by hard work, curiosity, and a deep love for her family.

Virginia began her career as the owner and operator of a travel agency, a role that perfectly suited her adventurous spirit and love of exploring new places. 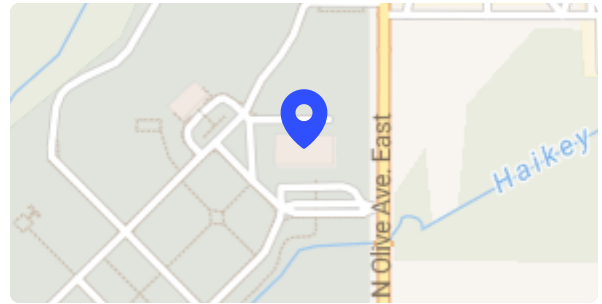

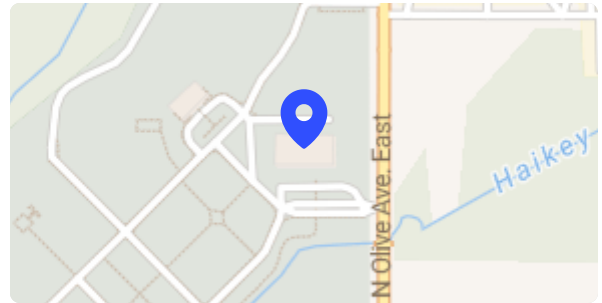

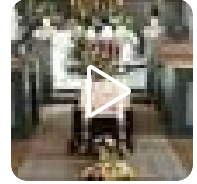
